THE POWER OF REGIONAL MUSEUMS

On August 25, 2022 ICR will have an off-site meeting which will be dedicated to the subject of The Power of Regional Museums.

We will be visiting three Czech regional museums: The two museums of Tomáš Garrigue Masaryk in Rakovník and in Lány, and Regional Museum in Jílnové near Prague.

After these three visits, we will follow the thoughts of ICOM Vice-President Dr. Laishun An's keynote at the ICR Annual Meeting 2021; demonstrating regional museums as driving and endogenous forces, cohesive and radiating power.

Regional museums are a reflection of their communities. They collect, research, and communicate tangible and intangible heritage while being sites for the creation of new knowledge and social interaction. As such, they can detect changes in society and become sources of cultural innovation.
